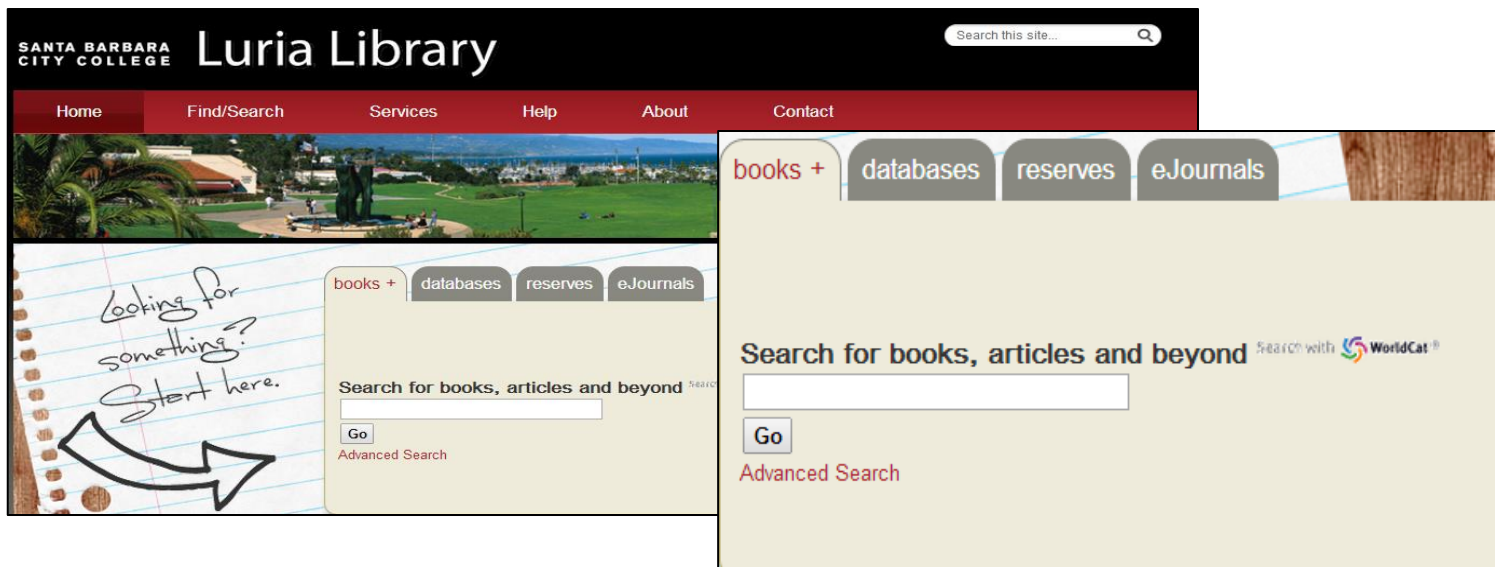


What do SBCC Library search tabs do?



Books+

- Searches the library catalog (a list of books, articles, and other items the library owns).
- Generates a results list based on search terms and indicates where an item is located.
- Provides a link to the full-text of a book or article online in a library database. Remember, if we don't own an item you can request it (article or book) through [Interlibrary Loan](#).

Databases

- Links to library databases (library material available through online subscription websites).
- Are arranged by subject area and can search for popular, scholarly, and eBook literature.
- Can be accessed with your pipeline account on and off campus **24/7**.

Reserves

- Links to course material(s) placed aside by your instructor for a class (electronically or in print).
- Searches for course material by course name, course number, or department.

EJournals

- Searches an exact periodical title (journal, newspaper, magazine, etc.) owned by the library.
- Links to a library database and locates the full text online, if we have access to it.
- Provides date ranges the title is available (from when to when) electronically.
